Terms and Conditions – Reviewed January 2023

In these terms and conditions 'you' will be used to refer to the adult making the booking and the adult accompanying the child at the Beach School session. It is acknowledged that this may not always be the same person. However, it is the responsibility of the adult making the booking and agreeing to the terms and conditions to inform any other accompanying adult of them. Brighton Beach School sessions

By booking a place at Brighton Beach School, you recognise that the sessions take place in the natural environment and therefore, have an element of personal risk and that. It is important that all present listen to and act upon all safety instructions given by Brighton Beach School or any appointed staff.

Our Liability

By booking a place at Brighton Beach School, you agree that Brighton Beach School, any appointed staff and the landowners will not be liable now, or at any time in the future for any loss, expense, damage or claim you may have against them for any damage to you, the children or your property as a result of participation in a Beach School session. Brighton Beach School will only accept liability for physical injury to any client that is proven to result from direct negligence on the part of Brighton Beach School.

Variation of content

Brighton Beach School sessions are subject to natural forces and whilst every reasonable effort is made to comply with course content, Brighton Beach School reserves the right to vary or modify a course itinerary at short notice in order to take advantage of naturally prevailing conditions.

You acknowledge that the information provided by Brighton Beach School is given to the best of our ability but, because of the variability of nature, it may be reasonable to alter or modify a course.

First Aid

In the event of an accident during a Brighton Beach School session, you agree to you or your child receiving immediate first aid by a qualified First Aider provided by the school. We will also ensure that there is always a member of staff fully trained in first aid at each session.

Payment

Unless agreed in writing, payment for Beach School is due six weeks prior to the session date. Late payment may result in cancellation of the booking or release of the date to others.

Clothing

You should ensure that you and the children are wearing appropriate clothes and shoes for the Beach session and the season. Please also bring a full set of spare clothes. Brighton Beach School will supply a letter detailing clothing required for the session.

Sickness

If you or any of the children develop an infectious illness you must not attend Brighton Beach School sessions for a minimum of 48 hours after the illness, in compliance with Department of Health guidance. If you have Covid-19, you must not attend Brighton Beach School. You must follow relevant Government advice.

Cancellations

In the event of extreme weather conditions and a decision is made by Brighton Beach School to cancel a session, you will be informed at the earliest opportunity via the contact email address given at the time of booking. An alternative date will be offered.

If you need to cancel the booking once fully paid, Brighton Beach School will do all possible to rebook the session for an alternative date. However, if cancellation occurs within 7 days of the booked session, a 50% cancellation fee will be applied.

Termination of services

Brighton Beach School reserves the right to terminate any booking immediately in the event that any fees remain unpaid or where any of the terms and conditions are breached. Brighton Beach School reserve the right to review and alter these terms and conditions at any time. You will receive an email notification regarding new terms and conditions.
